Wade Davis' *Light At The Edge Of The World: Science of the Mind* (2011) Documentary. Canadian anthropologist, ethno-botanist, photographer and National Geographic Explorer in residence, Wade Davis, journeys to Nepal and Mount Everest in his quest to understand the sacred teachings of Tibetan Buddhism at the source ... before its original practitioners vanish. Wade Davis has traveled the world studying linguistic and cultural diversity and expresses alarm that the earth has lost half of its 7000 languages (and therefore cultures) in just forty years.

Although technically not a religion, Buddhist thought has influenced Western culture significantly since 1959 when Shunryu Suzuki arrived in San Francisco and impacted the counter-culture movement with his quiet teachings.
